**THE ONTARIO TENDER FRUIT PRODUCERS' MARKETING BOARD**  
**PRICE DETERMINATION ORDER #3 - 2010**  
**ORDER MADE UNDER THE FARM PRODUCTS MARKETING ACT**

**INTERPRETATION:**

1. In this order:
  - (a) "Tender Fruit" means nectarines, peaches, pears, plums, sour cherries and sweet cherries produced in Ontario;
  - (b) "Group 1" means and includes the following varieties of fresh peaches: Harrow Diamond, PF-1, Springcrest, and other early season varieties;
  - (c) "Group 2" means and includes the following varieties of fresh peaches: Candor, Harrow Dawn, Early Redhaven, Garnet Beauty an Risingstar;
  - (d) "Group 3" means and includes the following varieties of fresh peaches: Brighton, Sunhaven an Sentinel;
  - (e) "Group 4" means and includes the following varieties of fresh peaches: Redhaven, PF-15A, Harbrite, Bellaire, Redstar and other mid-season varieties;
  - (g) "Group 5" means and includes the following varieties of fresh peaches: Harrow Fair, Starfire, Vivid and Blazingstar;
  - (h) "Group 6" means and includes the following varieties of fresh peaches: Harrow Beauty, Loring, Allstar, Coralstar, PF-17, PF-23 and PF-24-007; and
  - (i) "Group 7" means and includes the following varieties of fresh peaches: Cresthaven, Harcrest, Glowingstar, PF-25, PF-27A, Redskin and other late season varieties.

**PRICES:**

2. Effective July 24, 2010 and until further notice of the Ontario Tender Fruit Producers' Marketing Board, the prices set out in the attached Price Bulletin are the minimum prices for the varieties of tender fruit specified, and the said prices shall apply to both:
  - (a) F.O.B. prices at a platform of a dealer-shipper, in the tender fruit producing area in which the platform is located; and
  - (b) F.O.B. prices at a producer's farm where the tender fruit is sold by the producer otherwise than through an appointed dealer-shipper.
3. Prices determined in this order shall apply to all grades of tender fruit.

**REVOCATION:**

4. Price Determination Order #2 - 2010 made on July 12, 2010 is revoked and replaced by Price Determination #3 – 2010.
