Price Determination Order (Sweet Cherries) 2011

made under

THE FARM PRODUCTS MARKETING ACT

Interpretation

1. In this Order
 - (a) "buyer" means a person who buys sweet cherries and includes a dealer and a processor;
 - (b) "dealer" means a person engaged in buying, transporting or selling of sweet cherries;
 - (c) "local board" means The Ontario Tender Fruit Producers' Marketing Board;
 - (d) "processing" means the manufacture of tender fruit products or juice, beverage spirits or wine from tender fruit and includes the canning, bottling, distilling, fermenting, dehydrating, drying, freezing or processing with sugar or sulphur dioxide or any other chemical;
 - (e) "processor" means a person engaged in the business of processing sweet cherries;
 - (f) "producer" means a person engaged in the production of sweet cherries; and
 - (g) "sweet cherries" means sweet cherries produced in Ontario in 2010 except sweet cherries used for any purpose other than processing by a processor.

Application of Order

2. This Order provides for the control and regulation in any or all respects of the marketing within Ontario of sweet cherries including the prohibition of such marketing in whole or in part.

Prices

3. The minimum prices which shall be paid to producers for sweet cherries at the buyer's premises located in the area in which the sweet cherries are produced shall be as follows:

- (a) For all varieties of sweet cherries used for the fresh chilled pitted market at the rate of \$1,800.00 per ton; and
- (b) For all varieties of sweet cherries used for wine making, for juice making, or distilling by a winery or distillery licensed under the Liquor Control Act or for any other use not otherwise specified, at the rate of \$600.00 per ton.
