

THE ONTARIO FRESH GRAPE GROWERS' MARKETING BOARD
PRICE DETERMINATION ORDER #1 - 2008
MADE UNDER THE FARM PRODUCTS MARKETING ACT

INTERPRETATION

1. In this order:
 - (a) "Class 1 fresh grapes" means and includes the variety Sovereign Coronation;
 - (b) "Class 2 fresh grapes" means and includes the following varieties of blue grapes: Patricia, Van Buren, President, Concord, and Fredonia; and
 - (d) "Fresh grapes" means grapes produced in Ontario except grapes which are used by a processor for processing.

PRICES

2. Effective August 18, 2008 and until further order of the Ontario Fresh Grape Growers' Marketing Board, the prices set below are the minimum prices to be paid to producers for the classes of fresh grapes specified, and the said prices shall apply to both:
 - (a) F.O.B. prices at a platform of a dealer-shipper in the grape producing area in which the platform is located; and
 - (b) F.O.B. price at a producer's farm where the fresh grapes are sold by the producer otherwise than through an appointed dealer-shipper.

3. Prices determined in this order shall apply to all grades of fresh grapes.
