<sup>1</sup> **Does not apply to the following:** (a) a food that is imported, if the Compendium indicates that it must be labelled with a grade designation that is established by the foreign state of origin and the imported food is labelled with that grade designation rather than with a grade name, and the grade name must be shown in accordance with sections 205, 206 and 312 as if it were a grade name;

(b) prepackaged fresh fruits or vegetables that are imported, sold in their original container and labelled with a grade designation that is established by the foreign state of origin, if they meet the requirements of the foreign state in respect of that grade designation and those requirements are substantially equivalent to any requirements that apply under these Regulations; (c) imported prepackaged fresh fruits or vegetables, other than consumer prepackaged fresh fruits or vegetables, if they are graded and meet the requirements of the Compendium in respect of that grade;

<p>Note: Certain fresh vegetables of specific sizes only, namely asparagus, beets, carrots, sweet corn, greenhouse cucumbers, onions, parsnips, potatoes, rutabagas, field and greenhouse tomatoes, must be labelled with the applicable size designation, if any, and as required in Volume 2 of the Compendium. Labelling with the size designation also applies to untiered apples in specific instances.
